New Core Offer from 1st April 2013

- Weekly, monthly and holiday activities will continue for all CYP aged 5-25 years old who are resident in Rutland and have a Statement of Educational Need or is working at School Action Plus.
- 1-1 support to enable children and young people to access community activity available to those who have the highest level of need which will be indicated by being in receipt of Higher Level DLA (care component) or attending a special school and receiving Middle Rate DLA.
- Aiming High to provide up to 100 hours per annum of 1:1 support per annum if criteria is met.



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New Core Offer from 1st April 2013

- Regular Aiming High activities staffed to a level where you will not need to use your 1:1 support allocation. However, where a support worker is required, allocated hours will have to be used to attend community activities.
- RCC will only pay the cost of the support worker.
- Any mileage outside the County boundary (with the exception of travel to Peterborough, Stamford and Melton Mowbray) will also be charged to families at the rate of 45p per mile.
- There will be no charge for 1 to 1 support.
