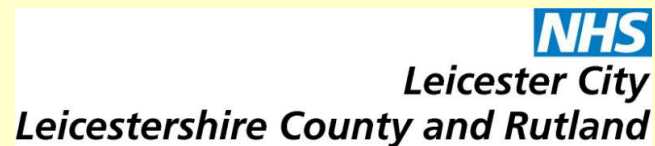

- Amelia Henry and Julia Kew, Health Facilitators help run the group

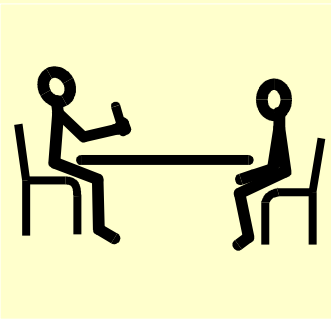

## Helping with the Big Health Day

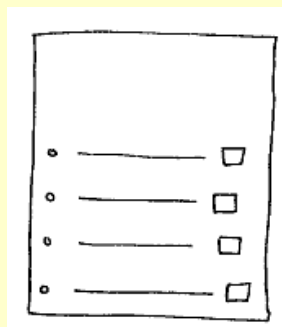
- We helped with presentations

- This was used as part of the evaluation- saying what was good about the day and how it could be better





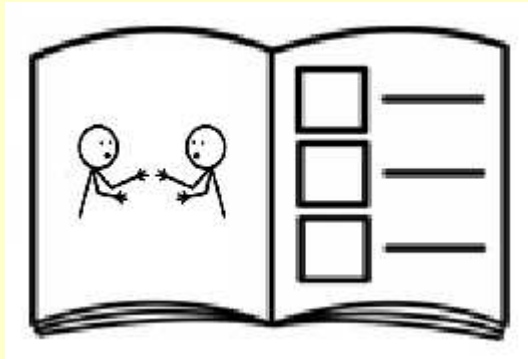
## **Easy write: helping to make health information easier to understand**

- **We learnt about the guidelines and practised using them**

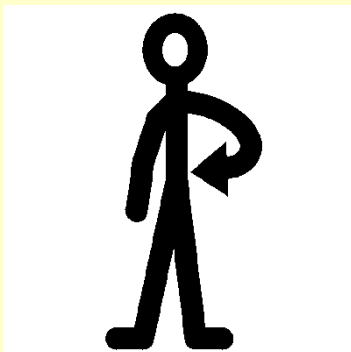

- **Helena told us about her communication passport and how it helps her**

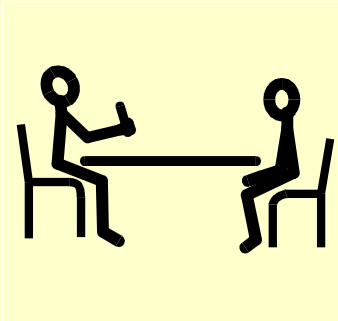
