What did we find out?



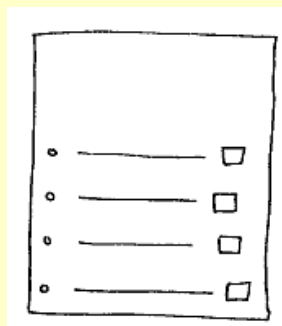
- **All the Health bosses were happy to sign up to the Mencap Charter**

Interviewing pharmacists

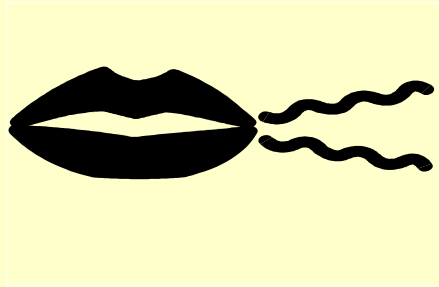
- Then we visited pharmacists in their chemist shops



- We asked them about what reasonable adjustments they make for people with learning disabilities



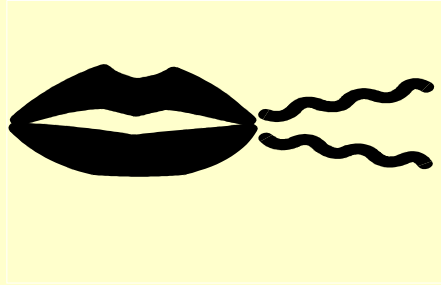
- We showed things they could use like easy read leaflets about medicines



Telling people about our work



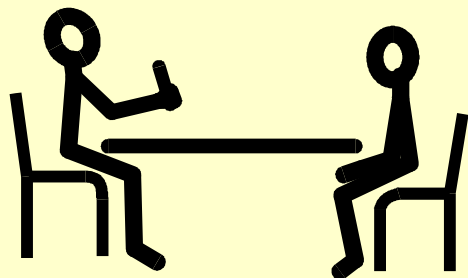
- We ran a workshop at the Health Celebration Day in April**

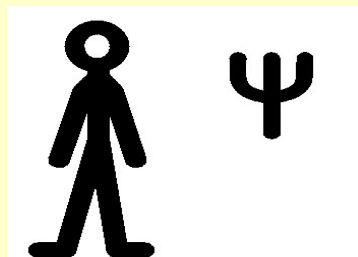

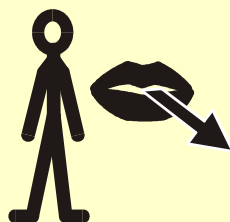


Involvement in interviews for new staff in the Adult Learning Disability Service
